EX PARTE JUDGMENT ENTRY
APPOINTMENT OF EMERGENCY GUARDIAN FOR INCOMPETENT PERSON
(R.C. 2111.02(B)(3))

Upon hearing the application for appointment of an emergency guardian herein the Court finds that _____ is incompetent by reason of _____ and further there exists emergency circumstances and that it is reasonably certain that immediate action is required to prevent significant injury to the person and/or estate of the proposed ward, that the proposed ward is incapable of taking care of _____ self and _____ property, and that an emergency guardianship is necessary.
