PROVISIONAL ORDER TO TRANSFER GUARDIANSHIP
[R.C. 2112.31]

This matter came before the Court for hearing on the Petition to Transfer Guardianship. The Court finds that evidence was presented that the ward is now physically present or is reasonably expected to move permanently to the other State. The Court finds that reasonable and sufficient plans for care and services for the ward in the other State have been made. The Court finds that adequate arrangements will be made for the management of the ward's estate in the other State. FINAL ORDER TO TRANSFER GUARDIANSHIP

This matter came before the Court for hearing on the Petition to Transfer Guardianship. The Court finds that upon hearing with notice to all interested parties, a Provisional Order to Transfer Guardianship was granted. The guardian has filed to be appointed guardian in the other State and a Provisional Order Accepting Transfer of Guardianship has been granted in the other State. The Court finds that the guardian has filed a motion to terminate the guardianship of the person estate or person and estate in this Court.

- It is ORDERED that the Petition to Transfer Guardianship be and hereby is granted and the Guardianship of the Person Only be and hereby is terminated.
- It is ORDERED that the Petition to Transfer Guardianship shall be granted upon the termination of the Guardianship of the Person and Estate or Estate Only on approval of the final account by Judgment Entry.
